Missed Tests

Tests will be scheduled and announced well in advance of the test date. Incomplete Assignments

All assignments will be given a due date by the teacher. This date will be clearly communicated to students.

Failure to submit an assignment by the due date will result in a final mark of zero on that assignment.

If a student has received a mark of zero on an assignment, they may request an alternate assignment by filling out an application form (available on the course website) and having it signed by a parent/guardian. Such requests must be submitted within seven days of the due date of the original assignment.

Alternate assignments will be due seven days from the date they are given (no extensions), and will be subject to a 10% late penalty. Alternate assignments will not be accepted if they are handed in after their due date.

Students may only request an alternate assignment once per original assignment.

Missed Labs

Due to the setup involved, labs must be completed during class time on the date scheduled. If a student is absent on the day of a lab they will be exempted from that particular lab.

Cheating

Cheating will not be tolerated. Anyone caught cheating on a test will be awarded a mark of zero for that assessment.

Cell Phones and Music Players
